Step 3: What to Include in Each Item

1. Artistic Resume

You may combine your artistic and teaching resume into one document.

Include:

- Your contact info
- Artistic training (schools, workshops, etc.)
- Art shows or exhibits you've participated in (when and where)
- A short statement (1–2 paragraphs) about your art

2. Teaching Resume

Include:

- Your contact info
- Training or education related to teaching
- Experience teaching art to children
 - - Where, when, what age, and what you taught
 - - Include work with children with disabilities (type of disability, when/where you taught, etc.)

3. Work Samples

- Visual Art: 3–4 digital images or link to your website
- Music: Audio files or website
- Performing Arts: DVD or link to video (dance, drama, storytelling, puppetry)

4. Statement of Philosophy

Write 3–4 paragraphs explaining:

- Your approach to teaching children
- How you adapt your teaching and art form for students with disabilities

5. References

Include 3 people who have worked with you as a teaching artist. These can be school principals, arts program directors, or arts administrators.

Important Notes

- All documents should be typed.
- Applications are accepted year-round.
- A background check is required to work with children.
- New teaching artists will be observed as part of a mentorship process.
- Pay is \$70–\$80 per contact hour for residencies upon completion of application process
