# ARTS FOR ALL

The Arts Association of Oldham County is excited to offer a series of FREE art classes for high school students with disabilities. The program is made possible through a partnership with Arts for All, a non-profit organization. All classes will take place after school at Gallery 104 in LaGrange. Instruction will be led by Laura Lenz Bowman followed with each student being paired with a gallery artist (Edd Johannemann, Jacqueline Bryan, or Leah Tenney) to collaboratively create a unique work of art.

Students will learn how to look at the world through artist eyes, observing composition techniques and incorporating elements of art. Students will explore photography, drawing, painting, and embroidery on their photos to create a unique work of art. The small class size of eight, lends itself to a community of inclusivity.

The classes will finish with a Gallery exhibit and reception.


## 2025 STUDENT TRAVELING EXHIBITION


